

Lomond School Means Tested Scholarships 2019

Following a very successful anniversary year celebrating 40 years of Lomond School, we are delighted to launch a new scholarship programme for day and boarding pupils from Junior 5 to Senior 6. It is our wish to offer the unique Lomond School experience to those young people who may not ordinarily have the means or opportunity to access it, and a range of scholarships will be awarded for the duration of full-time education.

Scholarships are categorised as follows:

- Academic Excellence
- Music
- The Creative Arts
- Sport
- The David Arthur All-Rounder Scholarship

The awarding of scholarships is dependent on entry criteria and all scholarships will be means-tested. A reduction of up to 50% of tuition / school fees may be available depending on individual circumstances.

It is expected that all scholarship pupils will be positive role models within the school community and will make a significant contribution to the wider life of the school.

Also available are a generous number of means-tested bursaries which can offer a significant reduction in fees. Please note that bursary applicants are not required to meet the scholarship criteria.

Deadline for early applications: Friday 29 March 2019

The application pack should be completed and submitted for consideration before close of business on Friday 29 March 2019.

Scholarship applicants and their parents/guardians will then be invited to tour the school and meet with the Principal and relevant teaching staff before undertaking interviews, testing and auditions (as appropriate) which will be held in early May 2019.

Should any scholarship places remain, a second deadline of Friday 24 May 2019 will apply, with tours, interviews and testing in early June 2019.
